Most projects are in the San Luis Valley; however, the ability to work in other parts of the state for a project's duration is required. The typical work schedule is 45 - 50 hours per week. Some weekends may be required.

4 -6 years construction experience is required with at least 2 years as a superintendent for general contract jobs. Qualified applicants must: be able to understand project plans and specifications; have basic computer skills; have a valid driver license with a clean driving record. Professional references that are able to speak about your GC superintendent experience is also required. Rough carpentry skills are preferred.

Position requires ability to climb, kneel, stoop, crouch, balance, squat, and tolerate heights as well as exert heavy physical effort. Work environment is typically outside on construction sites and may require work in confined spaces. Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs.
